

About Johns Hopkins Lacrosse

The Blue Jay men's and women's lacrosse programs compete at the NCAA Division I level as affiliate members of the Big Ten. The men's program is among the most accomplished in the history of college lacrosse as the Blue Jays have won 44 national championships, including nine NCAA titles, and have produced a national-record 184 First Team USILA All-Americans. The women's program has qualified for the NCAA Tournament 19 times with 10 appearances since transitioning to Division I in 1999. Off the field, the two teams combined to produce a league-high 68 Academic All-Big Ten selections in 2022.
